



Newsletter Editorial Policy

The purpose of the newsletter is to encourage a sense of community among members and friends of the church, and interest in and support for church programs.

Material for the newsletter will be accepted and edited at the discretion of the editor. Material relating directly to the church will have first priority; other material of interest will be published as space permits.

Priority will be assigned in roughly the following order:

- Sunday morning programs for the month ahead
- Church events for the month ahead
- Messages from the Minister, the President, the RE Director, Youth Program Coordinator and Music Director*
- News of church programs and committees
- Reports of past church events
- Church events up-coming *later* than the month ahead
- Personal news about members
- Events sponsored by and notices from other UU congregations and organizations in Vancouver and other parts of the province and CUC events
- Members' "Unclassified Ads"
- Events sponsored by, and notices from, non-Unitarian organizations which are consistent with Unitarian principles and are likely to be of interest to members. (Note: Submissions from non-Unitarian organizations unknown to the Editor will not be accepted. Such submissions should be routed through a board member or committee chair and will be considered with their recommendation.)

All Newsletter submissions must be identified by source.

* Messages should not exceed 600 words, unless discussed with the editor prior to submission.

The deadline is the 15th of the month. The newsletter will be emailed, picked up at the last Sunday service of the month, or sent by regular mail to those who do not use email.
